6. The Sound of Triumph

John 19:30

- Single greatest word ever uttered in history of world
- Not a weak cry, not a cry of defeat a cry of triumphant victory
- Two key ideas in one word It is over/done/ended
 - It is completed/accomplished/achieved
- Perfect tense it is finished and will remain that way
- What was finished? Many different facets (but not everything Jesus still had to be buried and rise, Holy Spirit still had to come)

1. What the World needed was accomplished

- Adam and Eve as our representatives had set world on downward course
- We needed a new representative to be the way back to God
- Jesus comes as our representative and break us out of the downward spiral and take us back to God
- He is your Covenant Head

2. What the Prophets looked for was accomplished

- All the key Old Testament figures looking for the Serpent Crusher
- Every prophet, priest and King was a picture of the coming Prophet-Priest-King
- Now the wait is over
- Every prophecy made about him and his death was completed
- He is your Long-awaited Rescuer

3. What the Sacrifices pointed to was accomplished

- Every sacrifice proclaimed that sin was punishable by death
- Jesus sacrifice means that they are all finished
- He is the true sacrifice the true Day of Atonement when sin is punished and taken away.
- He is your Sacrifice in your place

4. What the Father required was accomplished

- Father required perfection from us
- For 33 years Jesus lived the perfect life in our place
- All that is required for you to stand in God's presence (Ps 15) is achieved
- He is your Righteousness

5. What the Christian deserved as punishment was accomplished

- In his life, he lived the life we couldn't. In his death he died they death we deserved
- Wrath was poured out until it was finished
- His suffering was over



- There *is* nothing left to pay
- He is your Propitiation—wrath taker
- He is your Atonement (At-one-ment)—the one who reconciles us to God

6. What the Devil feared was accomplished

- Jesus came to triumph an defeat Satan
- On the cross he defeats forever the great enemy of God
- Christians are on the winning side
- He is your warrior King who has set you free and strengthens you to fight

7. What the Christian needs for life, joy, strength is accomplished

- At the cross Jesus purchased all we need for life and godliness 2 Peter 1:3
- At the cross we find all we need—we don't need to look elsewhere—no other secrets of living the Christian life. It's all found at the cross.
- He is your all sufficient Saviour
