### 7. The Sound of Trust

Luke 23:46

- Readiness for death requires faith – but faith must be grounded in truth
- Jesus' last cry shows faith and two grounds for faith

#### 1. A Relationship Restored

- The order of his cries: “Father” – “Forsaken!” – “Finished!” – “Father”
- Relationship with Father was ‘broken’ as he took our sins & punishment
- The relationship is now restored. Cries out for 2 reasons:
  - a) **His enemies needed to hear it**
  - b) **We need to hear that he was no longer under God’s wrath**
    - o He left the Father’s side to take us from forsakenness back to the Father
    - o Here we see him back with the Father – we too can be accepted
- Christianity is about a personal relationship with God, knowing him as Father

#### 2. A Sovereignty to Adore

- Jesus not a tragic victim – always in control
- Doesn’t die because of crucifixion – he gives up his spirit – He chooses!
- John 10:17-18 – “I lay down my life... no-one takes it from me...”
- He chooses death because that was what Adam & Eve had chosen for us
- Emphasis of NT: He gave himself – Heb 9:14, Titus 2:14, Mark 10:45
- Amazing if someone dies to save you, but beyond understanding that someone who didn’t have to die would choose death for you.
- He dismissed his spirit – something to fill us with wonder

#### 3. A Trust to Imitate

- “Into your hands I commit my spirit” – quoting Ps 31:5
- Ps 31 - The righteous man suffering unjustly keeping trusting God
- Jesus, the ultimate righteous man sets the example of trusting God in bleakest circumstances
- When you know God as father you can trust him no matter
  - a) **The Father only has tenderness towards you**
    - o All the wrath is past, he is now your father
  - b) **The Father provides absolute security**
    - o “No-one can snatch them out of my fathers hands” – John 10:29
  - c) **The Father will be with you no matter the circumstances**
    - o You can enjoy communion with God even in the hardest times
- Christians can trust the Father’s hands - because of relationship and his power
  - o Means that you can face life with confidence
  - o Means that you can face death with confidence based on facts
- Non-Christians can only fear falling into the father’s hands – Heb 10:26-31
