the Gospel according to

25. Christ - A Better Light Gen 3:22-24, Ex 25:31-40; John 1:1-8; Rev 22:1-27

- External: How to get into God's Presence. Internal: What it's like in God's Presence
- 2 rooms: The Holy Place (3 items); The Most Holy Place (1 item)
- Lampstand: 35kg hammered gold. Possibly 5ft high, 3ft wide. Always lit.

The Lampstand: A Tree of Life and Light

Significance is seen in what the lampstand is and what it does:

a) A Tree of Life

- Styled as a highly fruitful tree. An echo of Eden (Gen 2:9)
- Adam & Eve expelled, The way to the Tree of Life closed. (Gen 3:22-24)
- Here God saying, "There is a way back to the Tree of Life—via sacrifice"
- Almond tree—a picture of hope and new life

A Tree of Light

- Continuously lit. Burning a smokeless olive oil (Ex 27:20-21)
- A sign of welcome. God is present. Light = understanding, knowledge, meaning
- In God's presence there is meaning, and the darkness of life is dispelled

Christ: The Bringer of Life and Light

Everything in the Tabernacle points to Christ

a) Christ is the Light of the World

- I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12, see also John 1:1-6; 3:19-21.)
- We are lost in the darkness, and we love the darkness (John 3:19).
- Christ comes to guide us back to God's presence, giving meaning and hope.
- Christ is salvation and hope. To reject him means ultimate darkness (Matt 25:30)
- To accept him means living with him forever in the City of Tree of Life where he is the Light (Rev 22:3, 21:23)

Christ is the bringer of life

- "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." (John 10:10)
- His life was full and fruitful. He brings life the way it was meant to be.
- He entered our darkness on a tree of death so that we could have life and light.
- You need to go to him so that you have life and light that never fails

Christians: Called to be Light and Life


Some items in Tabernacle are pictures of us too


