Reading: Genesis 1-2

The Big Idea: God builds His perfect Kingdom

The big picture of the Bible is that of God building his Kingdom. It is made up of 4 building blocks. They are found throughout the Bible, but here in Gen 1-2 we are introduced to them for the first.

God - The King of the Kingdom 1:1-2:3

- All that there is He made it and he owns it
- He is the Author and Ruler

Mankind - The Citizens of the Kingdom 1:26-30, 2:21-25

- Dignity, purpose, significance
- Made for relationship with God

The Garden - The Place of the Kingdom 2:8:17

- A place of abundant provision
- A place where God is with his people
- A place where they *enjoy* God's presence and provision

A Command - The Rule of the King 2:16-17

- Trust the key to relationship
- Obedience the demonstration of trust
- Blessing the reward for obedience

God's Kingdom, the whole purpose of the universe, can be summarised:

God's people
in God's place
under God's rule
enjoying God's blessing
