JAGOB

15. The Fruit of Faith

Genesis 46:1-7, 29-34; 47:7-12

• Jacob has trusted God through great hardship – is it worth it?

1. You will find God's care in unknown situations – Gen 46:1-7

- Lots of unknowns in life how will we cope?
- Jacob heads for Egypt leaving Promised Land will God go with him?
- Stops to worship at edge of Promised Land
- God appears and shows his care for his followers

a) It is personal care

- Addresses Jacob by name, cares about details of his circumstances
- God is not just a God of the big things, but he cares for each of his people

b) It is faithful care

- God restates all his promises
- Jacob may have wandered far over the years, but God is still faithful

c) It is promise-laden care

- Four promises descendants, presence, return, meeting Joseph
- Promises his presence no matter where we go God is with his people

2. You will see God's purpose in hard situations - Gen 46:29-34

a) Purpose

- When Joseph disappeared, Jacob could only see a narrow piece of reality. Now he sees much more.
- Keep trusting and you will see God's purpose worked out in total

b) Provision

- Through the hard circumstances God was going to provide for Jacob and family in a much greater way.
- God will always provide as we keep trusting him

c) Proof

- The Cross is the ultimate proof that God will bring good
- At the Cross Jesus purchased all the joyful endings to all our sorrows
- We need to keep clinging to Christ in faith

3. You will bring God's blessing to others – Gen 47:7-12

- Jacob blesses Pharaoh not the other way round!
- God blesses his people in order for them to be a blessing
- We live in a famine of hope when we trust the great king, we display hope
- This life is a pilgrimage v 9 we may not see it all now, but one day we will, if we hold firm our faith to the end.
