

16. Ending with God at the Centre

Genesis 48:1-49:28

• 3 Consequences of having, and 1 way to keep God at the centre

1. Jacob can give thanks for the past

- He had many reasons to grumble but focuses on what God has done
- Thankful because he had met with God v3
- Thankful because of God's provision and protection v11, 15
- Thankful because God had rescued him v16
- Jacob is able to be thankful because he is no longer pursuing blessing but pursuing God.
- The more we focus on God the more we will be able to give thanks

2. Jacob refocuses attention on God's kingdom

- Jacob seeks to point Manasseh and Ephraim to God
- Tells them about the promises of God, the faith of their fathers, prays for them
- Teaches that God's ways are not built on natural order but on grace
- · Not simply a proud parent/grandparent, but concerned for their souls

3. Jacob rectifies past failings

- Jacob brings God's verdict on his first three sons Gen 49:1-7
- He is also putting right his failure to deal with them
- Where do you need to put past wrongs to right?

4. Jacob points us to Jesus - Gen 49:8-12

- Remarkable prophecy given about Judah
- 4 elements
 - o Praise v8 Judah will be worthy of great praise
 - o Power v9 a mighty figure to be taken seriously
 - \circ Authority & Victory v10 Picture of triumph and expansion
 - o Prosperity v11-12 a time of extravagant abundance
- Partially fulfilled under the kings of Judah David & Solomon
- But points forward to the greater king from Judah's family Jesus
 - o Praise He is worthy of all praise
 - o Power The Lion of Judah (Rv 5:5) triumphs over his enemies
 - o Rule One day he will come and every knee bow before him
 - o Prosperity He is the one who will bring abundant prosperity
- Listeners would wish they belonged to tribe of Judah. When we place our faith in Jesus we can enjoy the blessings of this great king
- As we trust and delight in Jesus, we will be able to keep God at the centre of our lives, living for him, thanking, focusing others on him and rectifying our failings.
