Genesis 25:29-34

• What is a Christian?

1. A Prize to be Prized

- Birthright not just the main share of the inheritance
- With Abraham's family line it meant all the blessings God promised too
- The greatest blessing was God himself, in all his glory and majesty
- For us Heaven, forgiveness, peace, delight & God himself

2. The Prize Despised

a) Esau – a man who lived for now

- Esau a man of the outdoors, impetuous, gruff, forceful
- Everything focused on the now little sense of perspective

b) Esau – a man who let the appetites of time dominate the future

- The hunter (Esau) gets caught in the trap his brother sets
- Driven solely by his appetites. His appetites cause him to exaggerate the important of the present not really about to die
- What appetites for the present drive you? Success, security, relationship, ease, getting by?
- When the now captures our thinking, we lose sight of what matters
- What dominates your thinking?

c) Esau – a man who lost his inheritance for nothing

- The essence of sin isn't just doing wrong, but a wrong valuation of God
- We don't give him his true worth, we value other things more highly
- Do we trade the greatness of God, sacrificed for us, for a nothingness?
- That will always leave us with a feeling of emptiness
- Do we get drawn into the humdrum of the ordinary and lose our appetite for what is valuable?
- See how a little thing can ruin us for all eternity

d) Esau – a man who didn't care until it was too late

- v34 walked off without a care. 27:34 there was no second chance
- God will not excuse those who despise the prize because it has been bought at a high price
- Jesus, the true and better older brother valued his inheritance and faced death so that we could share his inheritance.

Application

- A Christian is someone who grasps what is truly valuable & lives for it
- You need to set your eyes on eternity and prize what God prizes.
- You need to keep your eyes on the prize so that your inheritance shapes your decisions here and now.
