# 6. Jacob's Great Bananaskin

Genesis 29:1-30

Be patient - God hasn't finished with me yet

## 1. A New Believer's Mistake

- Jacob puts trust in God all going well
- But all is about to go wrong 3 mistakes Jacob made

# a) He relies on his own abilities

- Where is God in all of this? No mention
- Thinks he can cope with this himself
- Classic mistake of new Christians (and old ones too)

# b) He forgets to pray

- Compare Gen 24 What's missing? Prayer and worship
- God promises, God provides, but we need to respond
- How's your prayer life?

#### He is driven by his desires c)

- Rachel is beautiful. Jacob guided by testosterone not God
- v21 all he has been thinking about
- If we let our desires drive us we will crash and be hurt ٠

# 2. A Master Deceiver's Snare

- Laban is a master deceiver meet him 1<sup>st</sup> in Gen 24:30
- Pounces on Jacob's ridiculous offer & doesn't reveal customs ٠
- Jacob at fault, but the trap was well planned
- Need to learn to see the arch-deceiver Satan at work ٠

### a) He appears kind, but seeks control of you

# b) Nothing is ever short-term – always long term consequences

c) Disillusionment always results, not fulfilment

### d) When we get what we want, he ruins the enjoyment e) His aim is to hurt, not delight

- Two masters, one offers short term gain, but brings poison and ٠ hurt, the other (Jesus) offers long term gain and delight.
- What bait are you taking? ٠

#### Disciplined by a Loving God 3.

- Not rescued Jacob being taught vital lessons ٠
- v26 a piercing answer
- Passage full of parallels to Jacob's own cheating ٠
- Lesson 1 When you leave God out you are easy prey .
- Lesson 2 When you leave God out, you reap what you sow ٠
- Lesson 3 No more cheating old habits being removed ٠
- God discipines us for our own good to make us more Christ-like •
