9. Homeward Bound Genesis 31

Be patient - God hasn't finished with me yet

1. Called to return v1-21

- 20 years away, very successful now God speaks v3
- **Commanded by God** a)
 - Jacob comes back, not out of fear, but obedience ٠

b) An intrusive command

- Breaks into his prosperity in danger of getting too comfortable ٠
- Returning will mean upheaval and hard things to face

c) Encouragement to return

- From unexpected quarters Rachel and Leah agree ٠
- From negative circumstances Laban and sons not happy
- From God's promise when God commands he also promises
- From realising what God has done for him already v4-9

d) Responding in faith -v17

- Still many flaws v20, but hears call to return and obeys
- Puts his faith in the promises ٠
- God is calling all of us to return to him ٠
- God calls us to leave the comfortable and familiar and trust in him
- Don't let circumstances hold vou back God is in control of everything •
- You are not called to tidy yourself up first, but to come as you are

Application to Christians

- Are there areas where you need to return? "Leave at once"
- Are there areas where there will mean upheaval?
- Listen for God's encouragement ٠
- You are to be constantly returning

Pursued by a former master v22-30 2.

- He falsely accuses Jacob v26 ٠
- He falsely promises affection -v27, 28
- He falsely threatens harm -v29
- Yet God had him on a leash v24 .
- When you start to turn to God, or go forward in Christian life your ٠ old master rises up. Expect opposition to your progress in faith.
- Recognise that God has him on a leash keep going ٠

Strengthened by God to resist and return v31-56 3.

- Incident of idols shows inadequacy of other gods ٠
- True God commands v3, guides, honours v9, protects v24, cares v42 .
- This inspires and transforms Jacob to defy old master, to keep going •
- Look to God for strength to keep going, and he will give it
