

3. Two keys to Growth James 1:19-25

- James is passionate that God's people live out God's word
 - It's for Christ's glory His brother Jesus died so you could have the Gospel
 - It's for your good God's word restores and repairs us

1. Hear Christ's word v19-21

- v19-21 good advice generally, but specifically about hearing God's word
- 3 aspects of godly listening

a) Quick to Listen

• What slows your listening? Tiredness, laziness, priorities, short attention span, jumpy minds, prejudices, pick and mix listening

b) Slow to Speak

- Not always out loud we can argue with scripture, look for loopholes, justify ourselves, whine at God
- Stop talking and listen to God

c) Slow to Anger

- Anger hinders God's work in us, and our ability to hear God
- 2 causes v21: 0 Ignored sin we rage at others for sin we have!
 0 Pride we bristle at God's word

2. Do Christ's Word v22-25

Christianity is a whole new way of life – not just about dumping sins on Jesus

a) Listen Carefully

- Look 'intently' into God's word like Peter into Jesus' tomb not a fleeting glance
- Read your Bible, listen to sermons with deliberate concentration
- Search out how it applies don't let it wash over you.

b) Put it into Practice

- James repeatedly calls us to 'do it' v21, 23, 24, 25
- We are not accumulators of knowledge but doers of godliness
- Strong words for 'hearers-only' you con yourself into thinking you are fine
- James calls us to a continuous cycle of listening and doing v25
- After sermon/Bible reading, ask yourself: What truth do I need to thank God for? What do I need to do as a result of hearing this?

3. You will resemble Christ the Word

- "blessed in what he does" not because of what he does, but in the doing. 2 ways:
- \circ v21 "the word which can save you" = saving us from walking in harmful ways
- 2 Cor 3:18 as we look in the mirror of the Word we are being transformed into the likeness of Christ. The more you respond the more you resemble him.
