

7. Speaking like Jesus

James 3:1-12

- The tongue is one of the clearest indicators of genuine Christian faith 1:26
- Real Christianity is not simply about forgiveness, but about change

1. The Challenge of a Controlled Tongue

- A stern warning to those who have to talk a lot preachers v1
- You are what you say your tongue reveals your heart. (Matt 12:34)
- 3 questions to test our tongues

a) Where is your tongue out of control? v3-5a

- o Imagery of bit and rudder something small sets the course
- o Control your tongue or it will control you
- o Know where your tongue runs fast and free
- Make those areas matters for urgent prayer

b) Where is your tongue destructive? v5b-8

- As a spark does your tongue start things which get out of control? Gossip, flattery, opinion
- A poison like a snake ready to strike. Do you reherse arguments and putdowns in your head?
- \circ We can destroy not only others but ourselves

c) Where is your tongue inconsistent? v9-12

- o Is our speech the same around others as it is at church? At home?
- o Is our speech consistent with our faith? Anger, doubt, impatience?
- O Are the things you think/watch/hear consistent? Garbage in-garbage out

2. The Glory of a Controlled Tongue

- v2 What 'perfect man, never at fault in what he says' could James be thinking of?
- Jesus a man of perfect self controlled speech (John 7:46, 1 Peter 22,23)
- He speaks gently to the hurt and the lost He speaks well to you
- He also speaks well for you the wonder of the gospel is that Christ's perfect record covers ours

3. The Hope of a Controlled Tongue

- Is there hope? v8 No man can tame the tongue
- Yet James expects Christians to be different sweet, refreshing, nourishing speech is possible.
- The Christian has outside help has outside help
- The Christian is being made more and more Christ-like, and that includes our speech
