

# 9. Three misunderstandings about Christianity

James 4:1-12

#### 1. Christianity is more than surface change (1-3)

• Pulling the heads off dandelions won't stop them growing back

#### i. Look for the sin behind the sin (vs 1&2)

- James isn't looking for the apparent, surface cause, but the real, underlying cause.
- The main problem is the inward battles that are being fought in their hearts.
- If it was about surface causes then everyone would react the same way to challenging circumstances. They don't so it must be something deeper
- 'Desire' = sinful, self-indulgent desires. May start off as something ok but then take control.
- If you only try and fight sins on the surface it won't make much difference

#### ii. Look for the sin behind good things (v. 3)

- We can't just swap bad actions for good ones
- Even our good actions are affected by sin
- Jesus is our only hope of true, deep change

#### 2. Christianity is a relationship (4-6a)

- It's not about doing certain things and trying to live on the straight and narrow.
- Marriage is a brilliant picture of the difference between Christianity and religion

#### i. Our problem: We're in relationship with the world

"World" = life lived without reference to God.

#### ii. Our need: A relationship with Jesus

• True love is always jealous. It always has a proper intolerance of straying affection.

### iii. How can start such a relationship and stay faithful when in it?

- "But he gives us more grace" (v. 6)
- Jesus, the only perfectly faithful one, died for the unfaithful

#### 3. Christianity is about being taken down before you're lifted up (6b-12)

- How do we start this relationship and what should our lives look like if we're in it?
- The answer to both: "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up" (v.10)
- vs 7-9 show how we can do this
- We need to humbly submit to God's verdict of us, and turn from sin to him.
- He will then come near to us, forgive us and change us.
- vs 11-12 show what one of the results will be if we humble ourselves before God we'll not speak against our brother
- Going down before we go up is to follow the pattern of Jesus
