## 1. What are you living for?

The things which aren't worth living for a) Circumstances, success, money, a nice time, relationships 0

#### The One thing worth living for b)

- "For me, to live is Christ" 0
- Christ the one who lived a perfect life, died and rose again for our salvation. His person, work, kingdom, people, plans, gospel
- Jesus Christ dominates Paul's thinking 0
  - What takes up your spare thinking, spare time, spare money?
- Jesus Christ drives Paul's decisions 0
  - What motivates you?
- Jesus Christ defines Paul's identity 0
  - What defines you? Job, family, status? How do you see yourself?
- Jesus Christ delights Paul's desires 0
  - What gives you your greatest satisfaction?

#### The One thing alone c)

- Too often our lives are "For me to live is Christ plus 0
- Our progress and joy in the Christian life are conditional on 0 Christ being our greatest passion, not just one of them.
- Jesus means everything to Paul because he gave everything for Paul ٠
- We need to have experienced Christ's forgiveness to want to live for him
- We need to keep Christ's saving work in view in order to live for him

#### 2. What are you dying to get?

- "and to die is gain" v21 - Jesus Christ turns our greatest loss into our greatest profit – a win-win situation
  - Certainty, not uncertainty a)
  - "and be with Christ" For the Christian all uncertainties end at death 0
  - No delay, no soul sleep, no purgatory 0

#### **Relationship**, not just location b)

- "and be *with Christ*" a relationship to enjoy more of 0
- Rich reality, not dreary dullness c)
- "which is better by far" more rich and real than this world 0
- "The best of life is sometimes a little like Heaven" CS Lewis 0
- If Christ isn't our great delight here, what reason have we to think that we will enjoy or even enter Heaven?
