7. Naomi, Orpah & Ruth - Standing at a Crossroads

Ruth 1

emarkable God

Two roads diverged in a wood, and I — I took the one less travelled by, And that has made all the difference. (Robert Frost)

- Set at the same time as the Book of Judges. Dark, terrible times.
- The word 'return' is found 12 times. v6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 15(2), 16, . 21, 22(2). Also translated 'repent'.
- Six times in the direction of Moab, six in the direction of Bethlehem. .
- Which way will they go? Which way will you go? •

Orpah – All the right noises, but no real change 1.

- Starts off well v6, 9-10. But turns for home v14-15:
- Turning to God to please others is not enough
- Turning to God without being prepared to pay the cost is not enough •
- She went back home "What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, yet forfeit his soul?" - Mark 8:36
- Beginning the Christian life is not enough you have to go on in the Christian life.

Naomi – Not perfect, but going in the right direction 2.

- A Christian can be a follower of God and yet be very imperfect.
- Therefore the Christian's life is one of continual returning to God. .
- A woman of faith, but small thoughts of God v8-9; bitterness v13 20, 21; faithlessness v21; pride
- The right place to start v 21, "I went out". Accept the blame.
- Living with the scars can only be done when we return to God.

Ruth – Committed, whatever the cost 3.

- Ruth counted the cost of turning to God. .
- But she chose a new path, a new people, a new relationship
- She saw that this one thing was more important than anything else . in this life - Mark 10.29-31

4. God – Welcoming the repentant sinner

- Spoken of 11 times in 17 verses.
- "LORD" that special name that speaks of a personal relationship.
- "Almighty" a name that speaks of his power and faithfulness. •
- He welcomes those who come to him in repentance and faith.
- And a God who is mighty enough to take our lives and transform • them, scars and all.
- A call for all of us to stop in our lives and to turn again to God. To ٠ cast ourselves on him in desperate confident despair.
