

1. Grasping the contrast

Romans 1:1-17

- Religion and Christianity completely different. Man is made to worship
- But the default mode of the (fallen) human heart is religion .
- Christianity is different both in its message and its impact

A Different Message – Christianity is Good News

Rom 1:16-17-4 contrasts between being religious and being a Christian •

Christianity is good news not good advice a)

KOMANS

Beina a Christian instead

- "I am not ashamed of the gospel" 'gospel' means 'good news' 0
- Good news is something that has been done for you \cap
- Religion is good advice something to be done by you 0
- The Good news is about the Son of God (v2), becoming a man 0 (v3), to save men (v16), by dying and rising (v4) in their place.

b) Christianity is a gift not a demand

- "in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed" 0
- Religion is about demands do this and you'll be ok 0
- Good news God provides the righteousness we need to be accepted 0
- At the cross Jesus takes our sins and holds out his righteousness 0
- A Christian repents both of their sin and their righteousness 0

Christianity is about trust not effort c)

- "by faith from first to last... the righteous shall live by faith" 0
- Religion is about your efforts morality, church going, good deeds 0
- Christianity is about trusting Christ's effort on your behalf 0
- Trust in our effort makes us a prisoners to circumstances and feelings 0

d) Christianity is inside-out, not outside-in

- Religion is concerned about right behaviour change and be accepted
- The Gospel is the "power of God for salvation" be accepted, 0 and God will change you (from the inside out)
- Christianity allows you to be honest, not maintain a facade 0

2. A Different Impact – Christianity is powerful Good News

a) It brings real change for all types of people


- It changes the deeply religious (v1) "Paul" 0
- It changes the sophisticated city dwellers (v7) "to all in Rome" 0

b) It breeds humility not pride

- A hunger to serve "Paul, a servant" v1 0
- A hunger to learn from other Christians v11-12 0

It fires a desire to tell others not uncertainty c)

- "I am bound... I am so eager... I am not ashamed" 0
- Good news gives us something to tell the outcome is not in doubt
