

3. The need for a Rescuer

Romans 1:18-32

1. The need for Good news about righteousness - v18

- v17,18 "a righteousness from God is being revealed... for the wrath of God is being revealed"
- To get why the gospel is good news, we need to understand the bad news
- Yet God's wrath flows out of his love and delight in his creation

2. The Grim Exchange v19-32

- 3 grim exchanges show that man is a mess in need of rescue v23,25,26
- a. Reality for Fiction "suppress truth... exchange truth of God for a lie"
 - o Creation & Conscience speak to all people about existence of God
 - o The God of the Bible means we are dependant, accountable and guilty
 - o So we leave God out, or remake him creating our own version of reality

Consequences

- o v21,28 living in fiction leads to inability to see/think clearly
- b. The Living God for Lifeless idols "exchanged the immortal God for images"
 - We all worship something look to someone/thing to give us esteem, purpose, acceptance, happiness, hope, forgiveness, control
 - Only the glorious living God can provide all these

Consequences

- o When we fail our 'idols', they make us feel worse, with no forgiveness
- o v24: We become less human blind & deaf to other concerns/people
- o v24: We become enslaved our desires drive us to destruction
- c. Glory for Shame "exchanged natural for unatural"
 - o Paul gives a grim description of a 'Shameless' culture
 - o Both sexual relationships & social relationships are harmed
 - o Both deeply destructive and hurtful not what we were made for
 - o v32 delighting in wrong, and in urging others to do it

Consequences

- o v27 shameful behaviour brings its own problems
- o v28 we become victims of our own shameless thinking

3. The Glorious Exchange

- How does God react? 2 aspects
 - a. He lets people see consequences "Then God gave them over"
 - b. He performs his own glorious exchange (ch 3:21-26, also 2 Cor 5:21)
 - o On the cross Jesus bears the wrath 'given over' to death for us
 - o Living God became lifeless so we who deserved death could live
 - Resurrection confirms the glorious exchange: Glory⇒shame⇒glory.
 All who trust in Jesus' exchange will find themselves raised to glory
