Grasping what you have in Jesus

Eph 1:14-23

3 stages to Christian life outlined in ch 1:

- Finding the saviour v2
- Learning the facts v3-14
- Experiencing the reality of salvation v15-23

Initial lessons:

- Christians are people who trust Jesus and love God's people v15-16
- We need to pray for each other v15 Paul shows us how v17-23

1. Pray that you will Grasp your relationship with God v17

- What is the greatest thing you could pray for anyone?
- Our great problem is that we forget who God is
- Paul wants God's people to grasp the relationship that they have
- How? Not some mystical experience
- Think on the imagery of God used in the Bible until you feel the impact of it. Try to 'see' it.

2. Pray that you will Grasp where you are going v18a

- God has called us to a new and exciting world
- All the Christian's pain and loss is here
- All the non-Christian's pleasure and profit is here
- This gives us hope amidst trials and illness; gives us a sense of priority; gives us a sense of delighted urgency to share the *good* news
- We are to fix our eyes on the prize

3. Pray that you will Grasp your status with God v18b

- Balance in the Bible we are simultaneously saved and sinful
- Too often we get it out of balance see selves only as failures
- God redresses that balance
- Not our riches in view here, but God's riches WE are his riches! (also Exodus 19:5-6)
- Because of Jesus we are precious he will not let go of us
- As we grasp this we start to live up to it

4. Pray that you will grasp your help from God v19-23

- Christian life isn't easy. We are called to strive, struggle and wrestle
- But we don't do it on our own. We are to keep going to God for strength
- This is resurrection power power to live, power that brings life
- Nothing can resist this power
- That power is directed for the good of God's people v22-23
