9. When it's all bleak

· David's son has turned against him, David has had to flee for his life

# With God there is peace, hope and joy no matter how bleak the circumstances are

- Not a false peace from medication or lack of realism, not resignation
- Not peace after circumstances change peace in the circumstances
- How do we get it?

## 1. Don't let your circumstances push you away from God v1

- Circumstances are meant to turn us to God
- God is only one who can ultimately change us and our circumstances
- God is a God of mercy (v1)

## 2. Examine your Heart v4

- Often we examine our circumstances and not ourselves
- Our reactions reveal where our hope or our confidence lies
- We like to think are can be in control

## 3. Place your life in God's hands v5

• Go to the one who is in control

## By sacrifice - not ours, but Jesus' sacrifice

- o Sacrifice meant you had recognised and repented of wrong
- o Jesus' sacrifice means that we aren't estranged from God
- o Jesus' sacrifice will redeem every circumstance from bleakness

#### In trust

- o Trusting that God is your father and therefore doing what is best
- o Trusting that he will provide for you in every situation
- o Trusting that He can transform both us and our circumstances
- o Trusting that hindsight and insight will reveal His good purpose

## 4. Relish your relationship with God v3, 7,8

- David allowed his relationship with God to impact his thinking
- He reminds himself that he is God's child v3
- He reminds himself that he has access to his heavenly Father v3
- He reminds himself of God's protection v8
- This cultivates joy, and peace and hope than enables sleep v8
- David isn't overcome by bitterness, panic or fear because his peace and hope and joy are not found in his circumstances but in God
- Realising that God is your father makes all the difference
- Christian You need to let our heart be ruled by this reality.
- Not yet a Christian You need to ask Jesus to bring you into this reality
