

Songs for a Broken World

3. When you're feeling really down Psalm 42,43

- Can be taken as one long psalm similar theme and common refrain
- Honest words of a man experiencing intense hardship
- Believers are not immune to feeling down
- 1. The Reasons we can find ourselves Downcast
 - a) God seems far away (42:1,2)
 - $\circ \quad \mbox{We can feel weary and spiritually stale}$
 - b) Insults from hostile enemies (42:3, 10, 43:1)
 - $\circ \quad \mbox{We live in a hostile society} \\$
 - c) Loneliness (42:4)
 - Finding ourselves deserted gets us down
 - d) Overwhelmed by trials (42:7)
 - \circ $\;$ Rather than respond in bitterness we should respond with trust
 - 1 Cor 10:13 "God is faithful; he will not let you be tested beyond what you can bear. But when you are tested, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it."
 - e) Feeling forgotten by God (42:9, 43:2)
- If anyone ever had reason to be downcast surely it was Jesus?
- It's precisely because Jesus experienced actual forsakenness that we can find a cure
- 2. The Answer to finding ourselves Downcast
 - a) Place your emotions in the backseat
 - Talk to our souls instead of listening to our souls
 - b) Pray
 - Experiencing God's absence shouldn't paralyse prayer, but should prompt prayer
 - Should involve pouring out our souls to God
 - c) Public Worship
 - $\circ \quad \text{Realise the importance of worship} \\$
 - \circ Learn to love the psalms
 - d) Put your hope in God
 - 'Hope' in Scripture is trusting God for what he had promised to do but we have not yet experienced him doing it
 - Note there isn't a triumphant finish
 - We are not home yet in heaven we will know nothing of feeling downcast
