- Other Christians have what we would like
- Doesn't seem right or fair. Are you envious?

2. *He is Enough - v17-22*

- Asaph doesn't get what he wants, but he sees God as he is, and that is enough
- Asaph starts to look at world from Christian perspective
- Two truths help Asaph to see this:
 - a) **Whatever the non-Christian gets, he gets Hell v17-20**
 - b) **Whatever the Christian doesn't get, he gets God, now and forever v23,24**
 - We get God's goodness, we get glory, we get God's strength, and we get God - is that enough?
 - What if I envy another Christian?
