Thankfulness: How to end a year & end every day

Luke 17:11-19; 1 Thess 5:12-28

1. Thankfulness starts with a Right Attitude

We need a right attitude about ourselves

- We do not deserve anything from God God owes us nothing
- We need to remind ourselves of this daily
- This right attitude extends to our abilities we can do nothing without him

We need a right attitude about God

- If we pray only to get things to be thankful for, we abuse God
- A right attitude is love for the giver, not his gifts
- We need to remind ourselves of the difference between what we get and what we deserve

2. Reasons to be Thankful

- We are commanded Ps 103:2; 1 Thess 5:18; Eph 5:4,20; Phil 4:6
- Failure to do so disappoints our Saviour Luke 17:18. He had freed them from a living death
- Thankfulness delights our Saviour Ps 92:1
- It is an activity of Heaven Rev 4:9; 7:9-12; 11:16-17

3. Thankfulness will have a great impact our lives

- It will give us a greater awareness of God's goodness
- It will spur us on in our prayer life
- It will keep us from all kinds of sin: Pride & self-reliance, discouragement, greed, envy, bitterness, anger, self-pity
- It will give us peace and contentment Phil 4:6-7
- It will bring greater blessings Luke 17:19

4. How to be thankful

- Confess the sin of ingratitude and pray for a thankful spirit
- Keep a record of truths to be thankful for, and give thanks daily
- Keep a record of things asked for in prayer, give thanks as they are answered
- Review each day's events, giving thanks
- Give thanks in the following categories: Salvation, Bible, Church, Family & Friends, Daily Life, Other Christians, Work/Study
