The Silence of the Lamb

1. The innocent Lamb

- Jesus' accusers couldn't find any evidence against him, no matter how hard they looked.
- Even the false witnesses contradicted each other.
- This was predicted "though he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth" (Isa 53:6)

2. The willing Lamb

- Jesus could have exposed the trials as a sham.
- Instead he remained silent, condemning himself to death.
- "As a sheep before her shearers is silent, so he did not open his mouth" (Isa 53:7)

3. The sacrificial Lamb

- God's justice demands that sins be paid for.
- The Old Testament sacrifices point forward to Jesus, "the Lamb of God" (John 1:29)
- Jesus was on trial in the heavenly court our sins made him guilty.
- "For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors." (Isa 53:12)
