6:1-15 – Look to the Crown

Getting our vision corrected in Zechariah 1-6

- Is it worth believing?
- Chapter 6: The 8th vision and a concluding symbolic action

1. God will Judge the world v1-8

- Linked to 1st vision God was watching the world
- Looks as if there is no justice, but time will come
- Bronze mountains: God's presence an impregnable fortress
- Chariots: For battle, not surveillance (ch1)
- Judgment is certain, varied (different coloured horses), powerful, and inescapable (like the wind).

2. God is a promise-keeping God v12-15

- Symbolic action sums up all the visions
- Action (v9-11) explained in v12-15
- All God's promises about a saviour are being restated
- Trials and difficulties come, but God's promises are certain
- God does not abandon those who trust in him

3. You can have confidence in Jesus the Priest-King v9-15

- The symbolic crowning is designed to give exiles confidence in God's promises
- The roles of High Priest & King are combined in one Saviour Jesus

a) The King is your High Priest

- The one we have offended deals completely with our sin
- Therefore we can be certain about our forgiveness
- The High Priest intercedes for the people, and he has the power to supply our needs
- Therefore we can be certain of his loving care
- Look to his crown (of thorns) to see his tenderness and forgiveness

b) The High Priest is Your King

- The sacrificing one is mighty King of the earth
- Therefore:
 - He will built his church peoples from afar will come (v15).
 No heart is too hard. No place is too resistant.
 - You can and must obey him He will sit and rule (v13). No sin is excusable, or unbeatable.
 - You should live for his glory and not yours (v13) A king died for you. Live in such a way that shows Jesus to be great.
- Look to his crown (many crowns Rev 19:2) to see his power and authority.
